Gentle hills, baroque onion domes, fragrant meadows, brown piebald cows – a truly idyllic landscape around Bad Wörishofen in the Allgäu, 635 meters above sea level and only an hour's drive from Lake Constance – right in the middle between Munich and Lindau. This prominent Kneipp town is perfect for simply leaving everyday life behind and for enjoying a real treat for the soul.

Barefoot through the spa gardens

In Bad Wörishofen, a barefoot path was laid out in the middle of the beautiful 163,000 m² spa gardens, which is unparalleled. On 1,550 m the senses of the visitors are stimulated with different floral floor coverings. In addition to the barefoot path, there are many other things to discover in the spa gardens: scent and aroma gardens, medicinal herb gardens, rosarium and aviary.

Mindelheim – Historic old town



Gates and towers, churches and chapels, pointed gabled town houses in the magnificent Maximilianstraße invite you to discover and stroll. Enjoy the historical ensemble around the central Marienplatz in one of the numerous cafés. From the bay window of the town hall you are welcomed by the former lord of the town Georg of Frundsberg. The cozy alleys along the city wall offer unexpected insights and views. Treasures such as the "Durahansl", the world's second-longest clock pendulum or the award-winning nature teaching garden make the city a very special destination.

Mindelburg



A short walk leads you to the extensive castle "Mindelburg". It was once the residence of the Dukes of Teck and the Knights of Frundsberg. With its fortified bastions, gates and moats, it still corresponds to the ideas of a medieval castle complex today.

Kloster Irsee – Brewery restaurant with museum




The menu includes Allgäu and Bavarian classics such as a crispy roast pan, pickled wild boar roast, roasted pike-perch and also home-made Allgäu "Kässpatzen". In addition there is originally brewed monastery beer and more. Chimney vaults, an old restaurant, distillery or monastery parlor – in the centuries-old monastery restaurant you can enjoy a pleasant, relaxed atmosphere. During the warm

season, the summer garden in the inner courtyard and the monastery garden by the water wheel attract visitors. Children have fun on the playground.

In the brewery museum of the "Irseer Klosterbrauerei" the borders between the past and the present are blurred. From the museum, visitors have a direct view into the brewhouse, walk past the fermenting vats and descend into the cool cellar vault where the monastery drink slowly and steadily matures.

Landsberg am Lech



The city Landsberg am Lech fascinates by its charming scenic location on the steep bank of the river Lech and by the uniquely beautiful historical old town. The thundering Lechwehr (= dam), the still well-preserved ring of walls, the many towers and gates through which one can enter the town with its unmistakable main square, also gives a unique and lasting impression to those who, untroubled by all historical knowledge, only want to enjoy the beauties of this town. The districts of Ellighofen, Erpfting, Pitzling and Reisch are also worth seeing. They have retained their rural character and are idyllically embedded between forests and meadows.

Sights

Historical city hall, city wall with towers and gates (Bäckertor, Dachlturm, Schmalzturm, Sandauer Tor, Jungfernsprung = tower worth seeing in the city wall), Hexenviertel (the so called witches' quarter = artists' quarter), castle hill, Castle Pöring with castle church, Salzstadel (salt barn = historical building for salt trades in former times), Marienbrunnen (Mary's Fountain = fountain on the main square with the Virgin's stone statue)

Museums

City museum with art exhibitions, pillar hall at the city theater, Herkomer museum in the Mutterturm (mother tower = historical tower designed and built in honor of Herkomers mother), shoe museum Pflanz, fire department museum

Parks

English Garden on the west bank of the river Lech at the Lechwehr, Luna park at the Lechstraße

Churches and monasteries

Church of St. John's, Church of St. Benedict (in the district Sandau), Fountain Church at the foot of the castle hill, Holy Cross Church, Convent Church of the Ursulines, Parish Church of St. Maltese, St. Johann Baptist (in the district Pitzling), Parish Church of the Holy Angels
